PLASTIC BOTTLE PUPPETS



Rubbish can be fun! There are lots of new and exciting ways that we can reuse and recycle our rubbish. Why not make a set of fun story telling puppets.

WHAT YOU NEED:

Small clean plastic drinks bottles, short wooden sticks, plasticine, PVA glue, scrap paper, card, wool and fabrics, scissors and elastic bands.

WHAT TO DO

- 1. Decide on the characters that you would like to make. Have you got a favourite story that you would like to tell using the puppets?
- 2. Choose your materials think about what your character looks like to decide which materials you will need.
- **3.** Stick your bottle on to the table with a lump of plasticine to stop it rolling around while you make your puppet.
- Make some clothes for your puppet make a hole in the middle of some fabric, put it around the neck of the bottle and secure it with an elastic band.
- **5.** Add some eyes and nose and mouth and hair, by sticking paper, plastic and wool to the bottle.
- **6.** Push the stick into the neck of the bottle to finish your puppet.
- **7.** Work with a friend to tell a story using the puppets to the rest of the class. Maybe you could tell a story about rubbish or recycling?
