Mount Fuji is a stratovolcano that last erupted in 1707. This eruption was triggered by an earthquake, and the mountain has been dormant ever since. It was characterized as a Plinian eruption, with pumice, scoria, and ash shot into the stratosphere and raining down far east of the volcano.

It's said there was an initial earthquake with an explosion of cinders and ash that was followed some days later by more forceful ejections of rocks and stones.

Sadly, this Hōei eruption - as they call it now- is said to have caused the worst ash-fall disaster in Japanese history.
